The Kerplunks have three full-length albums since their inception in 2007. Their three albums are a mainstay in North American libraries and, due to this and their growing popularity, The Kerplunks are enjoying high CD sales across the USA and Canada.

Fronted by the dynamic female duo of Tina Jones (vocals, trumpet, baritone horn, trombone, kazoo) and Dinah D (vocals,

upright bass, banjo, mandolin, kazoo) and backed up by their talented male counterparts Aaron Cadwaladr (guitar, kazoo, vocals) and Phil Wipper (drums, vocals). The Kerplunks have played some of Canada's largest drawing and highest profile events - including The Vancouver 2010 Winter Olympics (Robson Square), The Vancouver International Children's Festival and The Winnipeg Folk Festival. Garnering rave reviews, The Kerplunks are enjoying bringing their high-energy show to audiences across Canada and look forward to international engagements.

The Kerplunks provide a unique live performance with a full four-piece multi-instrumental band, presenting a wide variety of upbeat lyrics and musical styles that even parents can enjoy. The Kerplunks get the whole audience singing along, on their feet and participating in the actions.
